A. Facts and impressions of Korea


- Most wired nation on earth

- Nearly homogenous (97% ethnic Korean)
- Population : About 51 million
- Capital city : Seoul (also largest city)
- Geography: very mountainous, peninsula (stunning ocean views, excellent hiking)
- Political system : Presidential Democracy
- Major religions: Christianity (protestant, catholic) or Buddhism
- Main language: Korean (official). English not widely spoken (high language barrier, the majority of signs and menus in this language)
- Money: The South Korean Won (KRW)
- Tipping: NIL. Top restaurants and luxury hotels sometimes add a service charge of 10 percent to the bill.
- Time : **GMT** +9
- Electricity: mostly 220 volts, 60Hz
- Internet domain: .kr
- International dialing code : +82. City or area codes are used, for example (02) for Seoul.
- Emergency contacts: 112 (generally have English speakers, reporting crime against foreigners, Police), 119 (fire and ambulance)
- Transport and driving: buses and taxies in all cities, metro stations in the main cities, driver's seat on the left
